## Department/Division Review of Human Research

## **Internal Approval**

## Scope

This policy applies to the Boston Children's Hospital (BCH) Research department and the respective staff.

## **Policy Statements**

This policy outlines the procedures for Department/Division review of human research. It also defines the criteria to be considered during the review process.

All research protocols submitted to the Institutional Review Board (IRB) must undergo Department/ Division review prior to IRB review.

Department/Division review is a separate process from Scientific Review, and typically occurs following Scientific Review (see: Scientific Review Policy).

Department Review is conducted by the Department Chair/Division Chief (or designee) in the home Department/Division of the Principal Investigator (PI) to attest that a protocol is approved for submission to the IRB, the PI meets the institutional requirements for serving as a PI, and the PI/research staff have appropriate resources and qualifications to perform the proposed research.

#### **Procedures**

# **Documentation of Department/Division Review Process**

Each Department Chair/Division Chief (or designee) provide documentation of Department/Division review via the electronic IRB submission system.

#### **Criteria for Department/Division Review**

In the submission of Department/Division review, the Department Chair/Division Chief (or designee) attests to the following:

- 1. The protocol has been approved for submission to the IRB.
- 2. The PI meets the institutional requirements for serving as a PI.
- 3. The PI and staff have:
  - a. The appropriate resources (funding, equipment, space, support services) to perform the research.
  - b. The time necessary to oversee the conduct of the research.
  - c. The appropriate qualifications, training, credentials/licensure to perform the associated research procedures.
- 4. The PI's plans for covering the expenses associated with providing medical care in the event of a research related adverse incident have been reviewed and approved.
